Hannie Rayson is a well-known Australian playwright. She graduated from Melbourne University and the Victorian College of the Arts. She was also awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Letters from La Trobe University.

Rayson was born March 31, 1957, in Melbourne. She co-founded the community theatre group, Theatre Works, and worked there for a number of years while writing. She has also worked as a freelance journalist.

Rayson is known for writing plays that deal with social issues and her 2003 play, *Inheritance*, appeared on the VCE text list from 2006 - 2009.
